1. EXECUTIVE OFFICER PROGRAMS (1 position tenable at the ACHAP Head Office)

Job purpose

The incumbent will provide leadership, management, and strategic direction for the Programs department; responsible for the effective delivery of all research, implementation and other programs or projects delivered by ACHAP in Botswana and the region. The Executive Officer Programs will access and coordinate the resources necessary for cost effective delivery, maintain high standards of department performance, provide overall quality assurance and ensure that accepted standards of accountability are maintained for all stakeholders.

- PhD in Health related field or equivalent qualifications
- Degree in Public Health or Business Administration (e.g., MBA), Public Administration, Management, Development Studies etc. With at least a Certificate in Project management
- At least 15 years of relevant experience post degree, of which 10 years should be in providing senior technical expertise for at least four of the following areas: HIV prevention, care and treatment; child health; maternal health; reproductive health; tuberculosis; Non-Communicable Diseases, health systems strengthening; quality improvement / quality assurance in health systems; or behavioural interventions
- At least 12 years of experience in public health programs in developing countries, preferably in the area of health policy and advocacy, or related areas
