

Questions and Responses

Q. Kindly clarify which organizations and or companies are eligible for this project and if there is any other documents to complete apart from the ones obtained from the website.

A. All organizations are eligible for funding. Civil Society Organizations, Non-profit organizations, Non-governmental Organizations and organizations with a mandate to support miners, ex-miners and mining communities are particularly encouraged to submit proposals.

Q. At this juncture are we expected to come up with a full proposal or we just have to fill in the provided grant application form?

A. At this time you are only required to submit the grant application form and requested attachments.

Q. In the TOR there is a statement which says “*Proposals should be submitted by 15:00hrs 17th May 2019 via email*” can you please clarify a bit in relation to the shared submission deadline in the tender advert i.e. 31st May 2019.

A. The due date is 31 May 2019, the mistake on the TOR has been corrected.

Q. Indicative budget (Budget ceiling) for a single SSR.

A. Each organization is anticipated to receive \$100,000 between contract signature date and the project end date 1 Dec 2020.

Q. Please provide clarification on the second item of the terms of reference regarding “engaging care providers/ managing occupational health service centers (OHSCs)

A. As part of the overall project, OHSC are operating in Botswana, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe. These are currently staffed with occupational health professionals who are providing services. The in-country grantee, is not responsible for hiring or managing these professionals. However, they will work with these OHSC professionals to ensure community mobilization for occupational health services within the facility as well as through mobile and outreach services.
